Read Judges 3:7-5:31. We are going to see the first few cycles of Judges in this session. Take note of anything that stands out to you. This page is for your notes, feel free to add questions and observations here as thoughts come to you throughout the week. (Remember, the first step to comprehension is good questions and observations!)
